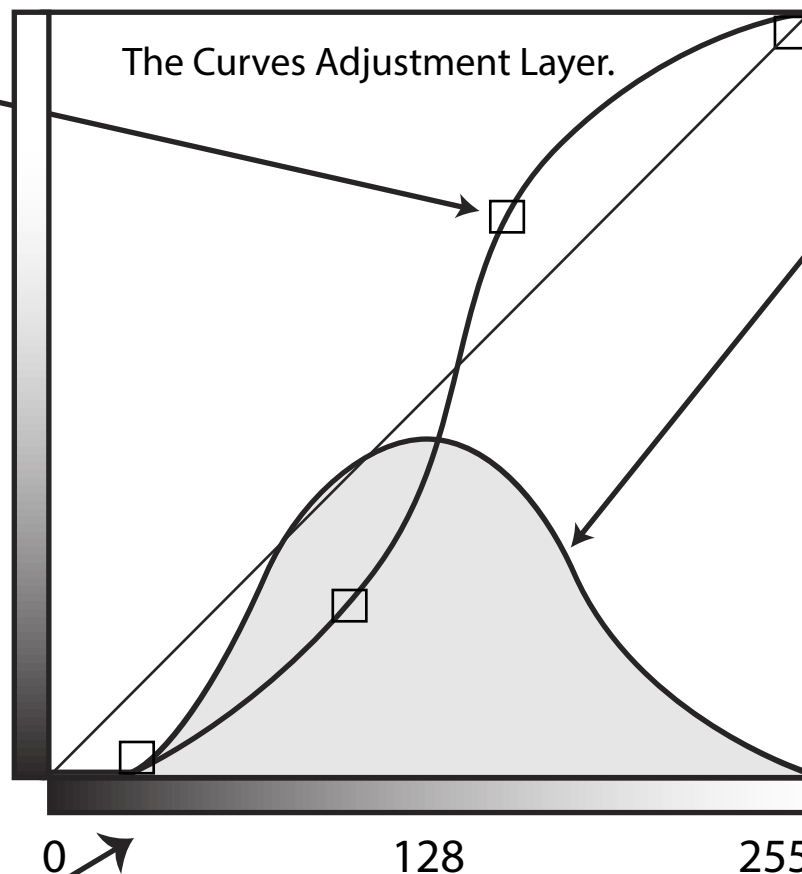


The curve is adjusted by dragging points to adjust color (RGB), contrast or to remap an image. Add points by clicking on the curve.

There can be up to 15 points on a curve.

When an image is remapped, the black point and/or white point are redefined and the histogram changes to reveal the new distribution of tones in the image.



The Curves adjustment layer displays the image's histogram that shows the distribution of tones within the image.

Down and left is darker, up and right is lighter, just like the linear response line.
